



## Timeline to SLL's

(Save Langebaan Lagoon) legal response to Saldanha Bay ADZ (Aquaculture Development Zone)

**Mid 2016** – DAFF ( Department of Agriculture , Forestry and fisheries) announces plans for Saldanha Bay ADZ – initial stakeholder identification process

**February 2017** - Save Langebaan Lagoon (SLL) is formed to appose the ADZ

**April 2017** – SLL submits 1<sup>st</sup> official letter of objection to DAFF (the developers) and Molapong Aquaculture

**August 2017** – FBAR is release by DAFF and Molapong Aquaculture ( Final Basic Assessment Reports )

**August 2017** – SLL submits 2<sup>nd</sup> letter of objection

**January 2018** – Late Minister Molewa of the DEA (Department of Environmental Affairs) grants Environmental Authorization to DAFF , Molapong Aquaculture and Southern Cross Salmon Farming

**Feb 2018** - SLL submits Official Appeal to DEA – this includes expert ecological and socio- economic reports

**June 2018** - SLL appeal is dismissed by late Minister Molewa of the DEA

**September 2018** – Independent legal opinion confirms good prospect of success for SLL in a judicial review

**December 2018** – Appointment of legal council to prepare and file notice of motion and founding affidavits to the Cape High Court for a judicial review .

**14 May 2019** – SLL council files papers in Cape High Court
